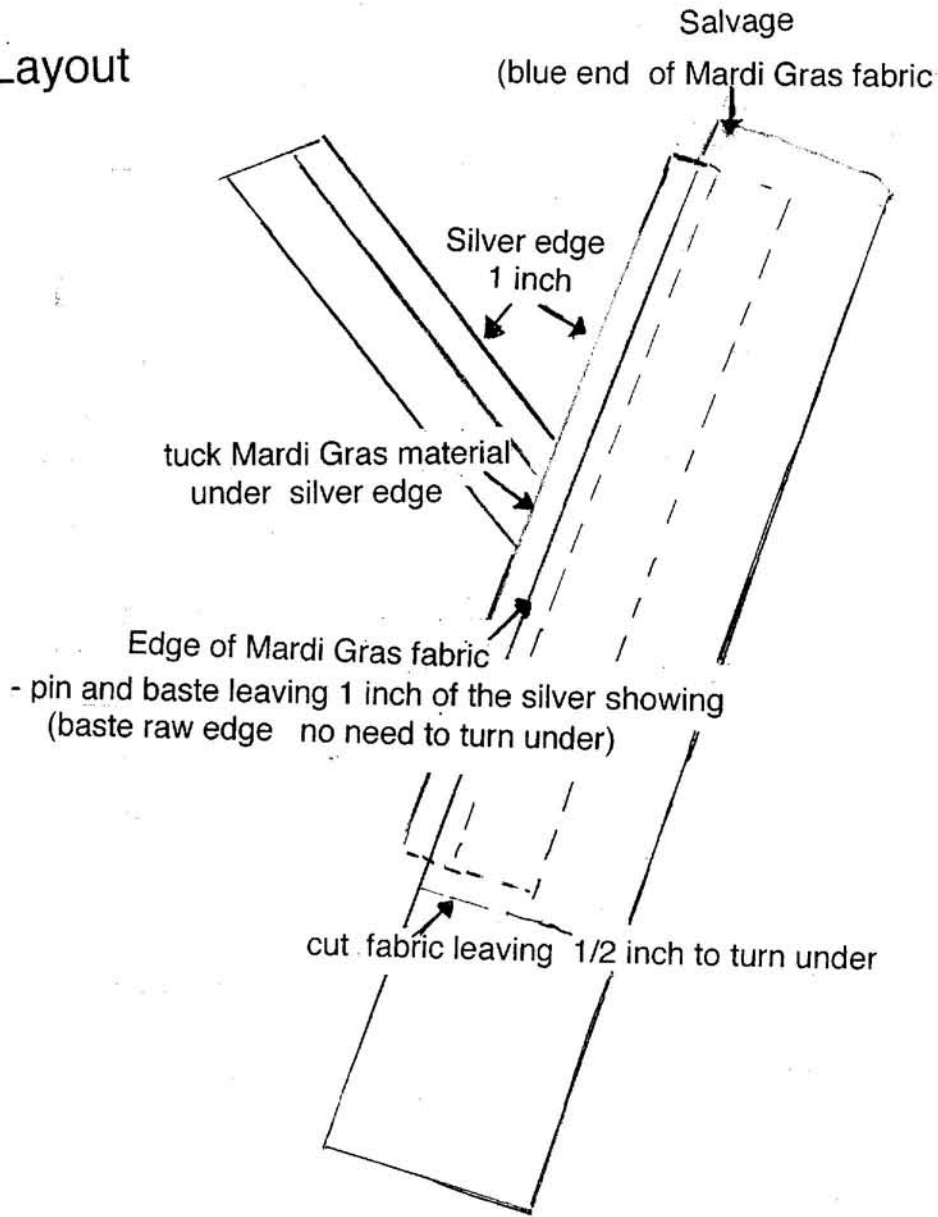


## Instructions for Covering Sash

1. Lay mardi gras material over the long side of the sash putting the blue chiffon at the top. You do not have to remove the green just place the material over it. Leave the plain blue chiffon overlapping the top of the sash to be used later to finish the shoulder edge
2. Pin and then baste the mardi gras material along the silver edge leaving 1 inch of the silver material showing. You **DO NOT** have to fold the material under for a finished edge.
3. Cut the remaining mardi gras material from the bottom of the sash leaving ½ inch to turn under at the bottom. Lay this material over the short side of the sash and repeat step 2. Note: Place the blue chiffon edge at the top again. The pattern does not have to face the same direction on both pieces. Tuck the material under the silver of the long sash where the two pieces meet (you may have to undo a couple of stitches)
4. To finish each sash fold the Mardi Gras material to the back. You should have 4 inches of material showing at the front. Do not worry if some of the green shows at the back. Pin and Baste.
5. Fold the material over at the ends and baste.

**Note:** If you remove the sash leave a strip of black showing at the neckline of the top when you reattach it.
